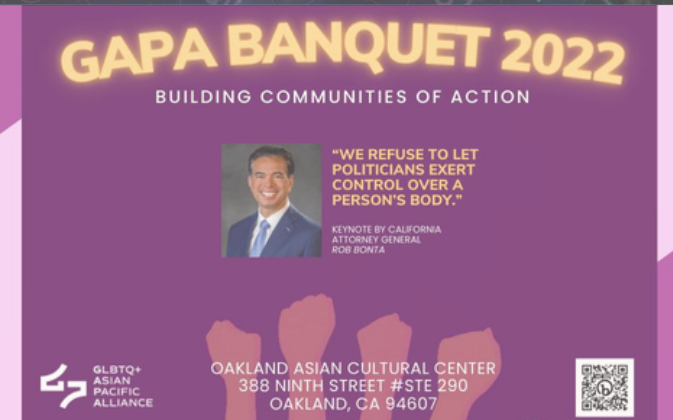

RESILIENCE & CELEBRATION 2022

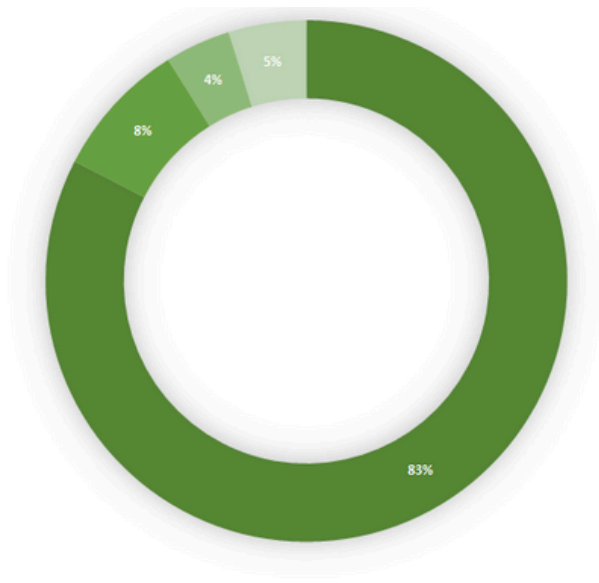
