HIGHLIGHTS

- Against the backdrop of political and cultural tensions surrounding drag performances, GLBTQ+ Asian Pacific Alliance, fiscally sponsored by GAPA Fund, hosted its annual Runway event, thematically entitled *Into the Looking Glass*.
 We celebrated our community's creativity and diversity with both drag and non-drag performances.
- The GAPA Men's Chorus performed at various local community events, including Filoli's *Dragtopia*! with preparations underway for their participation in the quadrennial GALA Festival in 2024, aiming to unite thousands of LGBTQ choral singers across North America and beyond after the event's cancellation in 2020 due to the pandemic.
- GAPA Fund fiscally sponsored the Bay Area QTAPI Coalition, which fosters collective cultural celebrations for the Queer and Transgender Asian and Pacific Islander community.
- GAPA Theatre provided support to ensemble artists and local productions.

To empower and advance queer and transgender Asian American and Pacific Islander voices by uplifting them through arts and cultural programs to foster understanding, visibility, and change.


